
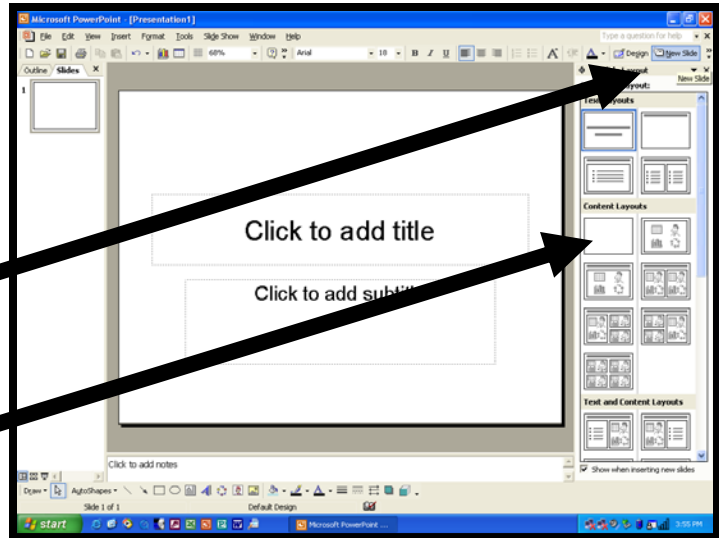


Simple Machines

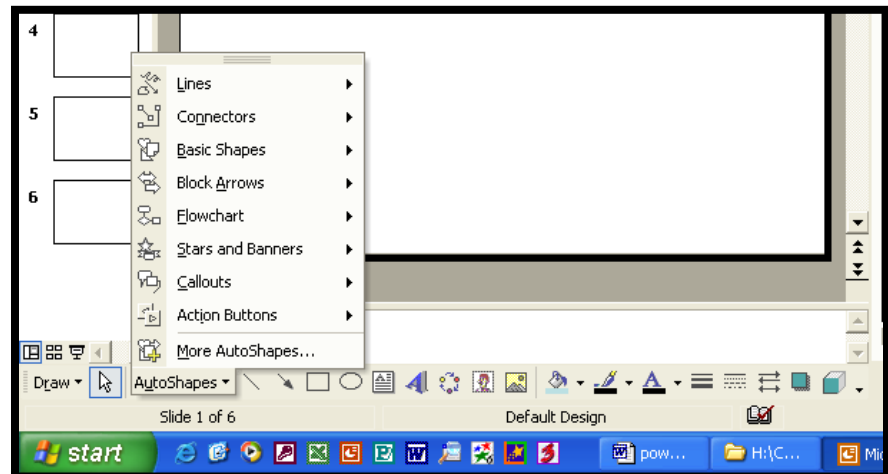
Power Point Slide Show

1. Open a blank power point by clicking on the orange square on the task bar at the bottom of the screen.
2. Click on the “New Slide” button at the top of the screen.
3. Click on the blank slide to remove the boxes on your PowerPoint.
4. Repeat this steps 2 & 3 until you have 6 slides without boxes.
5. Click on slide one. Add the Wordart title for the slide by clicking on the  icon and typing “Lever.” You can choose any style or color, but you want to have the same Wordart for all 6 slides.
6. Use the drawing toolbar across the bottom of the screen to draw the six different simple machines. Use the example on the back of this page to guide you. **BE SURE TO LABEL ANYTHING THAT I HAVE LABELED ON THE EXAMPLE!!!**



Hint #1:

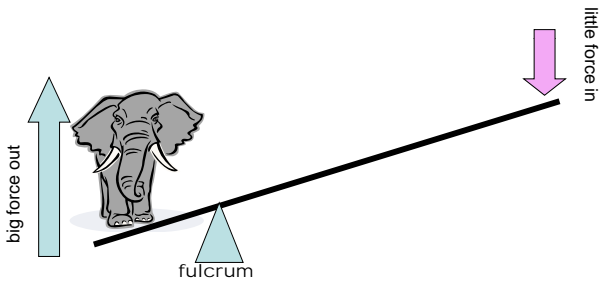
Click the word “AUTOSHAPES” on the bottom of the screen. This will let you draw shapes, arrows, and different types of lines.



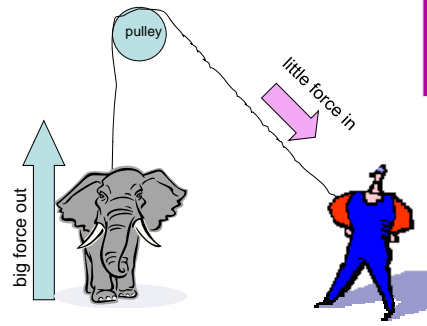
Hint #2: To change the color, thickness or style of anything that you have drawn, double click on it.

When you are finished, save as “Simple Machines” and go to Type to Learn 3.

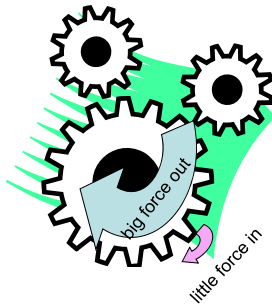

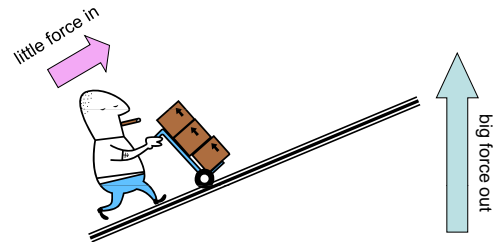
Pulley



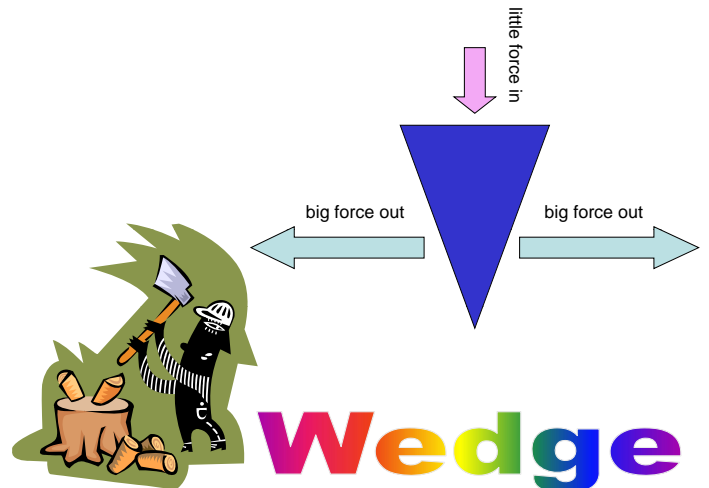
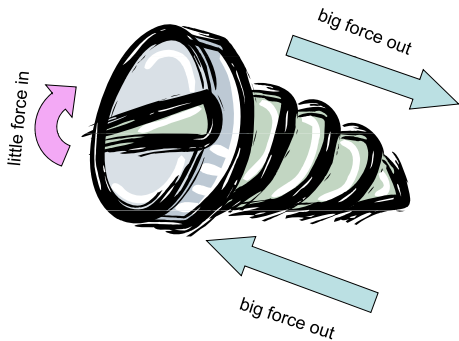
Wheel and Axle
